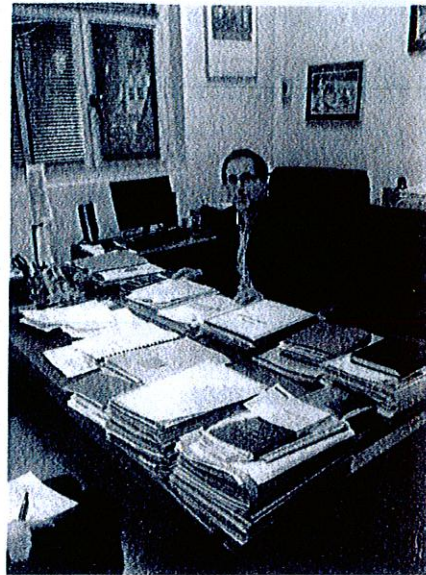

INTERVIEW WITH THE PISSARRO HEADMASTER

On Tuesday, January 21st, 2014, Mr. Jean-Paul Jouan was kind enough to answer questions from two première ES and S students belonging to the European English section: Miss Loyer Kahina and Mr. Puille Sebastian.

Jean-Paul Jouan: his studies and his professional experience.

In 1975, Mr. Jouan got a baccalaureate D' which corresponds approximately to today's baccalaureate S. (Agronomy Sciences)

After 5 years of study at the University of Rennes in psychology where he obtained his degree, he worked in a psychiatric clinic as a psychologist. But his desire was always to work in education.

He took the exam of orientation and psychologist counsellor, after which he did two years of training at the National Institute of Labour professional orientation. Then he worked in a centre of information and orientation at Mantes La Jolie, which is considered a difficult area.

In 1997, he accepted the job of psychologist at the UIT (University Institute of Technology) of Cergy and in parallel became a university teacher for 5 years.

In 1992, he passed the exam to become a school principal. He then became, for 4 years, the assistant principal at the high school Camille Claudel of Vauréal where there were many students (about 1500) because the Jouy le Moutier public high school had not yet been built.

In 1995, the Inspector of the Academy offered him a job as principal at the Simone de Beauvoir high school in Garges-lès-Gonesse. He worked one year there and no more because it is a difficult school and he feared possible reprisals against his young children given his status as a principal that had to enforce law and order.

Thereafter, he was 5 years as headmaster at the Agricultural College of Saint-Germain-en-Laye, before taking up the position of principal at Galilée High School in Cergy, where he stayed another 5 years. And now finally, he is headmaster in high school Camille Pissarro of Pontoise, where he has been since 2012.

Today, he is 57, including 22 years as a principal.

So you have practised in different institutions, what were your experiences?

From a professional point of view, in his career, he prefers the positions he held in high schools because they were the most interesting. For example, in Pissarro there is a fairly substantial size of staff: it has a great team. This allows him to focus more on the institution's projects; unlike in Vauréal, where he could only rely on a limited number of staff.

Indeed, his experience in college has pleased him less. He led projects such as the establishment of a relay class, a reading workshop to enable young pupils in difficulties to benefit from specialized supervision. But much of his time was taken up doing discipline rather than project development.

However he was struck by the interest and investment that Saint-Germain-en-Laye's students took in their education.

What is the international section? What does it offer compared to European classes?

It is different from the Euro class because it offers a deeper understanding of the language. It will be an English literature and History/Geography baccalaureate.

As with the European sections, there will be 2 hours of History and Geography in English. But for the baccalaureate, the exam in these subjects will be both written and oral and will count like the exams in other subjects, whereas in Euro section, the test is oral and only points above the average count.

He does not regret having invested in this project even if it is very complicated to implement.

When can we expect to see open the international section in our high school?

It will open next year, at the beginning of September 2014.

Does one rediscover the job of principal at each change of school?

He enjoyed working in Saint-Germain-en-Laye and also in the Galilee high school, Cergy. He left for reasons of mobility (a principal has the obligation to change schools every 9 years), so anticipated a desired mutation and applied for the direction of Pissarro.

In the Pissarro High School, he finds that the choice of different sections, including technology and business, is very interesting. In Pissarro high school, there is a majority of girls: 92% of girls in technological and vocational courses for 68% in the establishment overall.

He told us that changing settings is invigorating. He found different motivations to set up new projects, there is no routine or weariness there are changes of staff and partners.

He loves his job because for him, there is a connection between psychology (education students) and the economics (in the management of the establishment), two subjects he loves. He likes: having a lot of decisions to make, contact with people, and having great responsibilities.

You have studied psychology, do you regret not having led a faculty offering psychology programs?

He is not disappointed not to be specialized. He has not regretted his career choice for 22 years, although, as in all professions, there are moments of fatigue. His job suits him, he has a more stable situation (job security) and adequate pay.

In the region, the Galilée High School is known for its wide range of languages. Did you create these channels or did you develop them?

Galilee is indeed distinguished by the choice of languages, but he did not participate in this development. European English, German and Spanish classes were created with the School, then Italian, and then following the economic Boom of China, the Chinese class was created at the request of many families.

JACK THE RIPPER

WHERE DID HIS NICKNAME COME FROM ?

LETTERS AND PRESS COVERAGE

It is difficult to put an exact figure on the number of Jack the Ripper Letters that were sent by ordinary men and women because more than a century ago, people were so interested by these murders that they wanted to be detectives.

On 20th October 1888 the Illustrated Police news reported that the police had looked into the origin of over 700 letters.

Among all of them, some stand out, such as the Dear Boss letter or the 'From Hell' letter, which was accompanied by a half of a human kidney, believed to be Eddowes's.

The number of Jack the Ripper Suspects now runs to well over a hundred. Some of them are very likely to be Jack the Ripper, others are just downright ridiculous. But no one was ever punished for those crimes.

WAS HE ARRESTED ?

What all this shows is that interest in the Jack the Ripper crimes increases with each passing year and, with so many dedicated researchers and interested parties on his trail, the day may yet come when we see a definitive naming of the culprit responsible for all these murders, although they were committed so long ago.

Jack the Ripper came along at just the right time in just the right place and he frightened people in the same way as all these other fears were frightening people in Whitechapel in 1888. And Jack the Ripper, in many ways, became the embodiment, the physical embodiment of all these anxieties. The fact is that it did penetrate the consciousness of the people in a way that an ordinary murderer hadn't done in the past and would never do again.

THE LETTER 'DEAR BOSS'

The letter 'Dear Boss' was received by the Central News agency at their premises in the City of London on 27th September 1888. This letter gave its name to the legend.

Dear Boss,

I keep on hearing the police have caught me but they wont fix me just yet. I have laughed when they look so clever and talk about being on the right track. That joke about Leather Apron gave me real fits. I am down on whores and I shant quit ripping them till I do get buckled. Grand work the last job was. I gave the lady no time to squeal. How can they catch me now. I love my work and want to start again. You will soon hear of me with my funny little games. I saved some of the proper red stuff in a ginger beer bottle over the last job to write with but it went thick like glue and I cant use it. Red ink is fit enough I hope ha ha. The next job I do I shall clip the ladys ears off and send to the police officers just for jolly wouldn't you. Keep this letter back till I do a bit more work, then give it out straight. My knife's so nice and sharp I want to get to work right away if I get a chance.

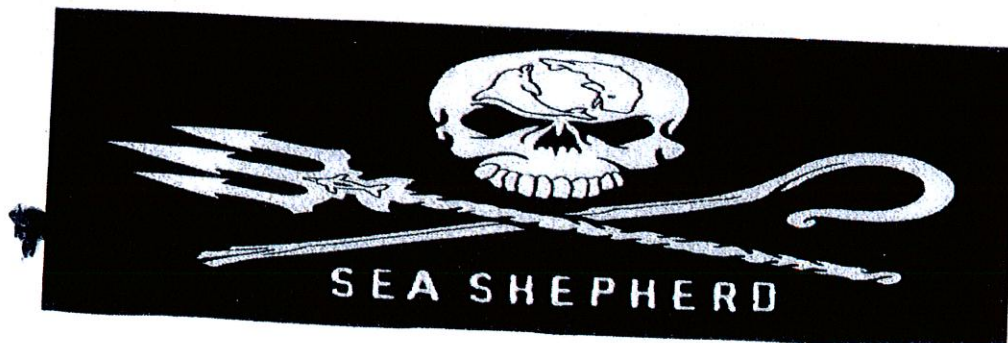
The US rock band, Red Hot Chili Peppers, will dedicate their headline show at Big Day Out to hardline conservationists Sea Shepherd.

Their performance will be accompanied by Sea Shepherd "digital visuals", incorporated into the main stage's backdrop. Red Hot Chili Peppers' lead singer, Anthony Kiedis, is on the board of directors for the organisation.

Last May, Kiedis called for German authorities to stop the extradition of Sea Shepherd Captain, Paul Watson, to Costa Rica. Sea Shepherd is no stranger to celebrity endorsements. Rock star Mick Jagger, surfing legend Kelly Slater and actors Christian Bale and Edward Norton are all benefactors of the group.

Last week, it was announced that former Greens leader Bob Brown was to take over Sea Shepherd's imminent Antarctic anti-whaling campaign.

Obituary

The Former South African President Nelson Mandela, died leaving behind him millions of people crying. The announcement was made by the current President of South Africa Jacob Zuma. Our dear Madiba's funeral will state," he said, announcing that the flags are at half-mast from Friday and until the funeral. His historic struggle tirelessly against apartheid made Mandela as a hero in South Africa and a symbol of peace in the world. His peaceful actions against racial segregation and the establishment of a democratic South Africa made him win the Nobel Peace Prize in 1993.

27 years in jail

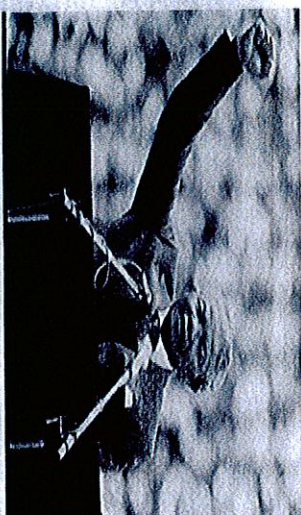
Arrested in 1962 and jailed in the fort of Johannesburg, Mandela was sentenced to life imprisonment in 1964 for sedition and narrowly escaped the death penalty. Then began a long imprisonment in Robben Island, located off the coast of Cape Town, where Mandela would spend his first eighteen years of imprisonment under the registration number 46664.

There he performed hard labor all day long in a lime quarry, where he broke stones. Under the sun and the dust for years, Mandela saw his health decline.

In this prison where the laws are enforced segregation, Mandela continued resistance and sought to penetrate the soul of his Afrikaner enemies, studying their history and language, in order to establish a dialogue with them. "When I walked through the doors of the prison, that was my mission: to liberate both the oppressed and the oppressor" he has said about it.

Transferred in 1982 to a prison in the outskirts of Cape Town, Mandela becomes a cause of international mobilization. Local and global pressure on the South African government also strongly influence his release, February 11, 1990. Thus began a period of negotiations with the government to end racial segregation.

At the head of the ANC (African National Congress) in 1991, Nelson Mandela became president of the country in 1994 after the victory of his party in the first multiracial general elections. He has been Chairman of the first non-racial government of the country, consists of a coalition between the ANC, the National Party and the Inkatha Freedom Party Zulu party, and promotes reconciliation between the races.

Weakened, he is not seeking a second term and left office in 1999, preferring to move away from politics to devote himself to his family and his foundation. His health declined over the 2000s, during which he was treated for prostate cancer.

Personal Life

As a Young man, he moved away from his family for refusing An arranged marriage. In 1947, he married Evelyn Mase, with whom he had a daughter (Makaziwe) and two son (Thembi and Makgatho, died of AIDS in 2005). June 14, 1958, he married Winnie Madikisela. Winnie Mandela could only meet her husband held twice a year in the prison on Robben Island.

Winnie put up Mandela after his release from jail, but they will split in 1992 (their divorce will be delivered in 1996).

The couple had two daughters: Zenani and Zindziswa. Mandela then approached Graça Machel, the widow of the first president of neighboring Mozambique, Samora Machel. They were married July 18, 1998, the day of the 80 years of Nelson Mandela.



All about the Qatar World Cup 2022

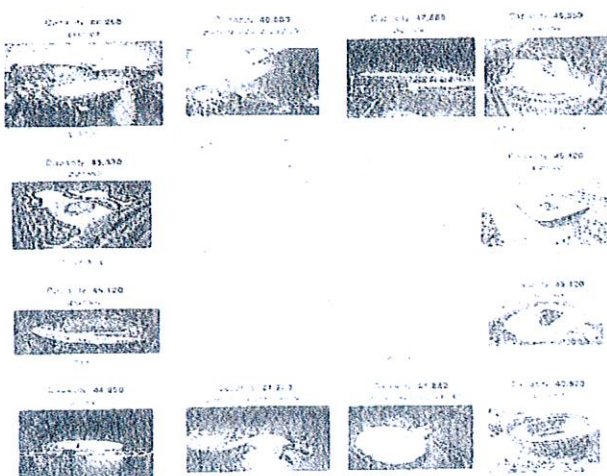
In 2014 the fifa world cup will take place in Brazil and we know nowadays that the 2022 edition will be in Qatar. Seb Blatter, the FIFA president is satisfied that the football federation has become a democracy.

Climate

In Qatar the weather can reach 50 degrees Celsius in summer, a summer tournament in Qatar would be impossible to everybody, football players, staff and fans ! Potential health risk is high risk in the summer. However the weather will be about 25 degrees Celsius in Winter, it is a temperature equivalent to a warm spring season in Europe ! It is perfect to play football ! The event will be played between November 15 and January 15 at the latest. If you play between November 15 and the end of December, that's the time when the weather conditions are at their best, when you can play in temperatures equivalent to a warm spring season in Europe, averaging 25 degrees. That would be perfect for playing football. The scheduling of the tournament has been debated since it was controversially awarded to Qatar in December 2010. Secretary General Jerome Valeke explained today in a Radio

France interview that in his view the 2022 FIFA World Cup must take place in winter and the best possible timeframe would be 15 November to 15 January. FIFA's general secretary admitted the tournament in Qatar would have to be played in WINTER. The World Cup does go ahead at the end of 2022, it could pose problems for the Africa Cup of Nations, which is scheduled for January 2023. Moving the tournament could also create problems for lucrative club competitions such as Europe's Champions League. It would probably create a logistical headache for many major European leagues. A tortuously slow process has led world football to a decision that will have huge ramifications for the global sporting calendar, the broadcasters and sponsors. Fifa world cup in winter ? It led to widespread ridicule comments on Twitter and Facebook with fans branding them "morons" and "idiots".

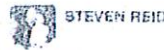

Modern Day Slavery

A report released by Amnesty International in November alleged that the abuse of migrant workers was rife within Qatar's construction sector. The Guardian's newspaper says that it is « modern-day slavery ». Migrant workers vulnerable to systematic abuse, they may not change jobs or even leave the country without their sponsor's permission. Nepalese workers in Qatar have been dying at a rate of one per day.

High Cost

The World Cup is going to cost Qatar approximately £138 billion, this is about 60 times the \$3.5 billion that South Africa spent on the 2010 FIFA World Cup. £107 billion would be spent on stadiums and facilities plus a further £31 billion on transport infrastructure. £30 billion would be spent on building air-conditioned stadiums with £48 billion on training facilities and accommodation for players and fans. £28 billion would be spent on creating a new city called Lusail that would surround the stadium, this is heaven, don't you think it ?

Alcohol and homosexuality in Qatar

Hassan Abdulla al Thawadi, chief executive of the Qatar 2022 World Cup bid, said the Muslim state would also permit alcohol consumption during the event. Specific fan-zones will be established where alcohol can be bought. Though legal with a permit, drinking in public is not permitted as Qatar's legal system is based on Sharia law.

The status of homosexuality as illegal in Qatar attracted attention in the media.

Fifa president Sepp Blatter said : « We are definitely living in a world of freedom and I'm sure when the World Cup will be in Qatar in 2022, there will be no problems »

Indeed, Barack Obama used to smoke marijuana in his youth, as he said « I smoked pot as a kid, and I view it as a bad habit and a vice, not very different

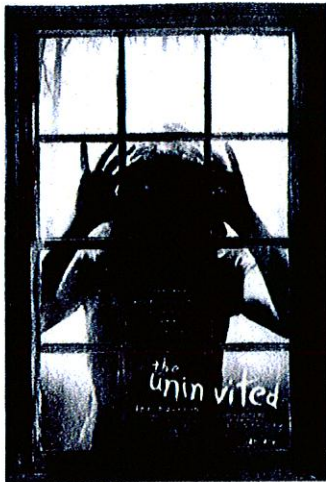
from the cigarettes that I smoked as a young person up through a big chunk of my adult life. I don't think it is more dangerous than alcohol » to the reporter.

Similar sizes shapes but have unique features to tell them apart, such as height, number of eyes, roundness or secondary features such as hair, pupils size or clothing.



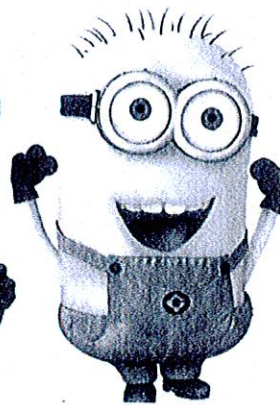
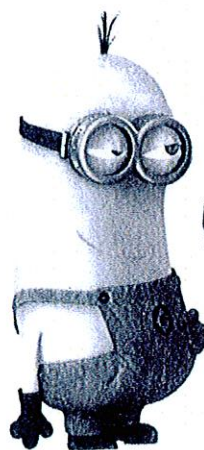
MINIONS IN THE WORLD
